Background

The food and drink industry uses large amounts of water and energy, and produces lots of waste. Envirowise and the Scottish Food Chain Group are working together to develop strategic support for the food and drink industry. These events are one outcome of this collaboration.

Why attend?

The events will provide you with practical tools to reduce costs and the latest information on a range of environmental aspects affecting the industry.

- Water is crucial to process control and is also a key raw material in many food and drink products - a tap dripping at 1 drop per second wastes nearly 5 000 litres a year, while a ruptured 50 mm pipe loses 700 litres a minute.
- The industry is the 4th highest industrial energy user - energy costs are rising and regulations such as the Climate Change Levy make energy a costly aspect of businesses.
- Waste is an unavoidable part of the industry - estimates put the cost of waste at approximately 4% of business turnover, with packaging waste alone representing some 13% of production costs.

*The Scottish Food Chain Group consists of representatives of the Scottish Food and Drink Federation (SFDF), the National Farmers Union of Scotland, the British Hospitality Association, the Scottish Grocers Federation, the Scottish Retail Consortium and the Sea Fish Industry Authority. The Scottish Food Chain Group is currently chaired by SFDF.
